In exercise of the powers conferred under section 22 (1) of the Biological Diversity Act 2002 (No. 18 of 2003) and in continuation of the Notification No. A. 36016/1/96-FST dated 17th January, 2006, the State Government hereby appoints the following members as Experts in the State Biodiversity Board.

The headquarters of the Mizoram Biodiversity Board shall be in the office of the PCCF, Mizoram at Aizawl.

Member Secretary of Mizoram Biodiversity Board shall be the Chief Wildlife Warden.

The functions of the State Biodiversity Board shall be to —

- (a) advise the State Government, subject to any guidelines issued by the Central Government, on matters relating to the conservation of biodiversity, sustainable use of its components and equitable sharing of the benefits arising out of the utilization of biological resources;
- (b) regulating by granting of approvals or otherwise requests for commercial utilization or bio-survey and bio-utilization of any biological resource of Indians.
- (c) perform such other functions as may be necessary to carry out of the provisions of this Act or as may be prescribed by the State Government.
- (d) prepare, in such form and at such time in each financial year as may be prescribed, its annual report, giving a full account of its activities during the previous financial year, and submit a copy thereof to the State Government.
