**NOTIFICATION**

No. A. 12031/2/90-HMP, the 20th January, 2006. Whereas it has come to the notice of the Government that some employees of the Government of Mizoram have resorted to strike and have remained absent from their places of duty.

And whereas the Governor of Mizoram having regard to the circumstances prevailing in the State of Mizoram is satisfied that, in the public interest, it is necessary to prohibit strikes in certain essential services;

And whereas any public service in connection with the affairs of the State in the Secretariat, Departments and Districts or Local Administration have been specified as essential services under the Mizoram Essential Services Maintenance Act, 1990 (Clause No. VIII of Section 2, Mizoram Essential Services Maintenance Act, 1990).

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Mizoram Essential Services Maintenance Act, 1990 (Mizoram Act No. 16 1990) the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to prohibit strike in any service connected directly or indirectly with the functioning of public services in connection with the affairs of the State in the Secretariat, Departments and Districts or Local Administration in the State.

No person employed in any essential services to which this order relates shall resort to strike or remain absent from his/her place of duty.

Any strike by person(s) employed in any service connected with public service in connection with the affairs of the State in the Secretariat, Departments and Districts or Local Administration commencing before or after the issuance

of this order shall be illegal and any violation shall be liable to punishment in accordance with the provisions of law for the time being in force in the State.

This order shall take immediate effect and shall remain in force for a period of six months unless revoked earlier.
