#### NOTIFICATION

No.B.16011/16/06-HFW, the 2<sup>th</sup> March, 2007. In supercession of all previous notifications on the subject, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to constitute the following Medical Boards to assess various general health issues including medical referred to various institutions outside Mizoram as below -

#### A. MEDICAL BOARD UNDER MIZORAM GOVERNMENT :

1. MEDICAL BOARD AT CIVIL HOSPITAL AIZAWL
  - 1) Medical Superintendent = Chairman
  - 2) Two senior most specialist = Members
2. MEDICAL BOARD AT CIVIL HOSPITAL, LUNGLEI
  - 1) Medical Superintendent = Chairman
  - 2) Two senior most specialist = Members

This Board will consider all cases not covered by the Mizoram Govt. Group Health Scheme 2006. Provision and Final Permission etc. will continue to be dealt by DHME.

#### B. MEDICAL BOARD UNDER MIZORAM GOVERNMENT GROUP HEALTH SCHEME 2006

1. MEDICAL BOARD AT CIVIL HOSPITAL, AIZAWL
  1. Medical Superintendent = Chairman
  2. Two senior most specialist = Members
  3. Representative of ICICI Lombard = Member  
General Insurance having MBBS Degree
2. MEDICAL BOARD AT CIVIL HOSPITAL, LUNGLEI
  1. Medical Superintendent = Chairman
  2. Two Senior most specialist = Members
  3. Representative at ICICI Lombard = Member  
General Insurance having MBBS Degree

The decision of Medical Board at 'B' above will be final and binding. The following clarifications are also made as follows -

1. Review cases need not be routed through the Medical Board.
2. Patients are allowed to choose their preferred Hospital.
3. The number of attendant/attendants will be as per recommendation of the Board.
4. Diet charges will be as prescribed by Govt. of Mizoram from time to time and diet charges will also cover attendants.
5. Govt. run hospitals (Central/State) are automatically approved. Bill of these hospitals will be re-imbursible where cashless facilities are not available.
