2. In exercise of the powers under sub-section 3 of section 5 of the Act, the Governor of Mizoram is also pleased to empower the Board to give children in adoption in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Rules.

Notwithstanding, the Board may adopt a set of Rules of Procedure in conformity with the Act and the Rules for smooth functioning under intimation to the constituting Authority.

The Board will hold its sittings in the premises of an observation Home while dealing with the cases of children in conflict with law and in the premises of a Children's Home while dealing with the cases of adoption at least once in a month or in less duration depending upon the number of cases to be disposed.

3. The Board will have jurisdiction over the Districts of Lunglei, Saiha and Lawngtlai.

4. The Board will have a tenure of 3 years from the date of issue of this Notification. The tenure of the Members will be co-terminus with the tenure of the Board.
