NOTIFICATION

No. J. 11012/1/02-HFW, the 10th July, 2007. In order to prevent the spread of HIV/AIDS and to facilitate a strong multi-sectoral response to combat effectively, the Government of India has constituted a National Council on AIDS(NCA) with Hon'ble Prime Minister as Chairman, to provide policy directions to HIV/AIDS programmes and mainstream HIV issue into all Ministries. It is felt that a similar system is required at the State level to scale up the HIV/AIDS programme and facilitate multi-sectoral response. As HIV/AIDS has become a developmental challenge, a response from each and every sector, both public and private, is needed to combat the epidemic. Considering the need for the expanding the interventions, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to constitute the State Council on AIDS (SCA) as mentioned below with immediate effect.

TERMS OF REFERENCES

1. To review HIV/AIDS response in the State and provide policy directions to HIV/AIDS program.
