NO.LA/ESTT.70/2007(APC)/29, the 22nd November, 2007. The Hon'ble Speaker in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 4 of The Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1995 as amended from time to time, is pleased to accept the Report and recommendations of the First Report of Assembly Pay Committee, 2007 for new pay scales for the posts as shown in Appendix - 'A' of the Report in the Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat.

The new pay scales shall come into force with effect from the 1st December, 2007. Initial pay in the new pay scales shall be fixed under the provisions of F.R. 22(1)(a)(2).

FIRST REPORT OF THE ASSEMBLY PAY COMMITTEE

- 1.1 Recruitment and Conditions of Service of persons appointed to Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat are regulated by The Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1995 as amended from time to time; and the Speaker is empowered to have full administrative and financial powers in respect of the Legislature Secretariat by the aforesaid rules.
- 1.2 The Second Sitting of General Purposes Committee held on 26th June, 1998 recommended that Pay Committee exclusively for Assembly Secretariat be constituted by the Hon'ble Speaker (copy of the minutes at Appendix - B). In pursuant to aforesaid recommendation of General

Purposes Committee, the Speaker had constituted Legislature Pay Committee with the following members :-

The Secretary, Mizoram Legislative Assembly will be associated with the Committee.

- 1.3 The functions of the Pay Committee shall be :
To advise the Speaker on the changes that are considered desirable in the structure of the scales of pay and allowances of the Officers and all the categories of employees of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat in the context of the decision of the Government of Mizoram on the recommendation of The Fifth Pay Commission.
- 1.4 The Committee at its First meeting held on 22.7.1999 resolved that all employees of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat should provisionally draw pay according to the standard conversion of scale adopted by the Government of Mizoram until such times the Assembly Pay Committee considered and finalised the pay scales for the employees of the Assembly Secretariat (copy of the minutes at Appendix - C). An order to this effect was issued by the Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat on 22.7.1999 vide No.LA-60/ACCTS/99(APC) dt. 22.7.1999. (copy enclosed at Appendix D).
- 1.5 The Committee held 3 (three) sittings on 22.7.1999, 26.10.2000 and 19.8.2002 to consider anomalies in the pay structures of some posts in the Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat.
- 1.6 Before finalisation of its Report, the Committee ceased to exist due to the expiration of the term of the 4th Legislative Assembly.
- 1.7 In the meantime, the Government of Mizoram vide Notification No.G. 11013/1/2005-FIN(PRU) dt. 22.2.2005 constituted a Pay Commission to review and rationalise the pay structure of the employees of the State Government of Mizoram with a view to remove their grievances arising out of anomalies in the structure of the pay scales. The Pay Commission in its Report submitted to the Government of Mizoram at para 1.21 stated that Assembly Secretariat is outside the purview of the Commission and no recommendation is therefore made in respect of the employees of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat. The Government of Mizoram vide Notification No.G.12017/3/2007-FIN(PRU)/B dt.28.8.2007 and No.G.1103/4/2007-FIN(PRU)/A dt. 28.8.2007 raised the pay scales of some Group 'A' and 'B' Officers under the Government of Mizoram.

- 1.8 The Hon'ble Speaker vide Notification No.LA/ESTT.70/2007(APC)/1 dated 26th July, 2007 constituted new Assembly Pay Committee for the Secretariat of Mizoram Legislative Assembly consisting of the following members :

The Secretary of Mizoram Legislative Assembly will be associated with the Committee.

The functions of the Committee shall be :

- 1) To advise the Speaker on the changes that are considered desirable in the structure of pay and allowances of the Officers and all categories of Staff including isolated posts in the context of the decisions regarding pay etc. by the Government of Mizoram.
 - 2) To make recommendations to the Speaker as early as possible.
- 1.9 The Committee held 2 (two) sittings on 22.8.2007 and 22.10.2007 to consider the structure of Pay and Allowances of the Officers and all categories of Staff including isolated posts in the Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat.
- 1.10 After careful examination of the existing pay structures of various posts in Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat, the Committee decided that in view of the pending implementation on the recommendation of the Report of the Mizoram Pay Commission 2005, by the Government of Mizoram, only isolated posts which have no corresponding post/pay in the executive departments be taken up for consideration.
- 1.11 The Committee, therefore, recommends new pay scales for the posts specified in the Appendix 'A' for the Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat. The Committee further recommends that fixation of pay in the new scales and determination of allowances in respect of each individual case shall be done under the provisions of F.R. 22(1)(a)(2).

At the outset the Speaker and Chairman of the Committee explained to the members that it would not be possible to hold meeting of the Committee in the near future to consider the structure of scales for Assembly Secretariat Employees due to pre-occupation in the Budget Session which is going on. He said that it was necessary that the officers and all other employees of the Assembly Secretariat should also draw pay and allowances in the Revised Pay Scales until such time Assembly Pay Committee finalised structure of pay scales and recommend necessary changes, if any. The Chairman invited members to subscribe their views.

The Chief Minister explained to the Committee the policy of the Government in regards to adoption of the 5th Pay Commission Recommendations by the Government of Mizoram and said to the extent that Pay Implementation Committee is still to be formed to consider anomalies in the pay structure. He suggested that employees of all categories of posts in the Assembly Secretariat might be allowed to draw according to the standard conversion of the scales approved by the government and issued under the Mizoram Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1999 until such time the Assembly Pay Committee considered and finalised the pay scales to be adopted by the Assembly Secretariat.

In the light of the explanation given by the Chief Minister the committee resolved that all employees of the Mizoram Assembly Secretariat should provisionally draw pay according to the standard conversion of scales adopted by the Government of Mizoram until such time the Assembly Pay Committee considered and finalised the pay scales for the employees of the Assembly Secretariat.

The meeting adjourned sine die.
